

THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES
(AMENDMENT) BILL, 2017

BILL

further to amend the Payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951.

Preamble.—WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the Payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951 for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted in the Sixty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act may be called the Payment of Salaries and Allowances (Amendment) Act, 2017.

(2) Section 3 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 20th day of June, 2016 and the remaining section shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of section 8A.*—In the Payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951 (XIV of 1951) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in sub-section (5B) of section 8A, for the words “ twelve thousand and five hundred” the words “ twenty thousand” shall, be substituted.

3. *Amendment of section 8B.*—In section 8B of the principal Act, for the words “ five lakhs” and “ten lakhs” , the words “ten lakhs” and “twenty lakhs” shall, respectively, be substituted.
