### THE KERALA REPEALING AND SAVING BILL, 2016

A

#### BILL

to repeal certain enactments which are obsolete or no longer needed.

*Preamble.*—WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal certain enactments which are obsolete or no longer needed;

BE it enacted in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:---

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Kerala Repealing and Saving Act, 2016.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Repeal of certain enactments.—The enactments specified in the Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed.

3. Saving.—(1) The repeal by this Act of any enactment specified in the Schedule shall not affect any other enactment in which the repealed enactment has been applied, incorporated or referred to and this Act shall not affect the validity, invalidity, effect or consequences of anything already done or suffered, or any right, title, obligation or liability already acquired, accrued or incurred or any remedy or proceeding in respect thereof, or any release or discharge of, or from, any debt, penalty, obligation, liability, claim or demand, or any indemnity already granted, or the proof of any past act or thing;

nor shall this Act affect any principle or rule of law, or established jurisdiction, form or course of pleading, practice or procedure or existing usage, custom, privilege, restriction, exemption, office or appointment, notwithstanding that the same respectively may have been in any manner affirmed, recognised or derived by, in or from any enactment hereby repealed;

nor shall the repeal by this Act of any enactment revive or restore any jurisdiction, office, custom, liability, right, title, privilege, restriction, exemption, usage, practice, procedure or other matter or thing not now existing or in force.

(2) The provisions of section 4 of the Kerala Interpretation and General Clauses Act, 1125 (VII of 1125) shall be applicable in respect of repeal of an enactment by this Act.

# STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The periodical repealing of Acts help to remove from the Statute Book those laws which are obsolete or are no longer needed. Expired enactments having been limited to endure only for specified period or purpose or which had been enacted for the continuance of previous temporary enactments need not be kept alive in the Statute Book. Obsolete enactments which are no longer capable of being put into force or which have exhausted its operation by the accomplishment of the objects also can be removed from the Statute Book.

2. Amendment Acts are not necessary to be retained in the Statute Book as separate Acts since they became part of their parent Acts.

3. Law Reforms Commission under the Chairmanship of Justice (Retd.) V. R. Krishna lyer appointed by the State Government, recommended the Government to repeal the enactments which are obsolete or no longer required and on the basis of the recommendation the Government have examined the matter and decided to repeal such enactments.

4. The Bill seeks to achieve the above object.
