# PROCEEDINGS OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER KERALA INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT FUND BOARD, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

Order No: APR-3/137/2017/KIIFB Dated 27/07/2017

Sub: KIIFB – Project Upgrading one school from each L.A. Constituency as a Centre of Excellence 11 Sub-projects (37 schools) as Phase I in 12 districts – Final Approval and Sanction for funding – Orders Issued.

Government, through the Budget Speech 2017-18, announced a scheme 'Upgrading one school from each L.A. Constituency as a Centre of Excellence', to be taken up as a project funded by KIIFB. Consequently, the General Education Department in Government, vide Government Order road 2<sup>nd</sup> above, designated Kerala infrastructure and Technology for Education (KITE) as the Special Purpose Vehicle for executing the project

Accordingly, Detailed Project Reports in respect of converting 37 schools in 12 districts as Centre of Excellence were submitted to KIIFB, based on Administrative Sanction issued vide Government Order read 1st above

The Sub-Projects submitted were evaluated for adherence to KIIF stipulations, as per GO(Ms) No.315/16/Fin dated 08.08.2016, and were found satisfactory and compliant.

The Board, after considering the Appraisal Report, resolved to fund the Eleven numbers of Sub-Projects listed below, approved vide G O (Rt) No.1237/2017/G.Edn dated 03.05.2017, limiting the proposed outlay to **Rs. 110.15 Crore** against the original proposed of Rs. 220.21 crore

However, the procedure adopted for fixing the quantum for each School had to be revisited for ensuring an outcome projected through the Budget-Speech, which was to allot every school, either an amount of Rs. Five crore, or the project cost subject to a maximum of Rs. Five crore. Accordingly, KIIF funding for the 37 schools had to be enhanced to Rs 184 26 crore.

The resultant additional quantum of Rs.74.11 crore—was placed before the KLFB Executive Committee for approval, abiding by the 29° Board Meeting Decision that funding approval upter and including Rs.100 crore in cases of Projects without Revenue streams would be the prerought vision that Executive Committee.

The Executive Committee has approved the funding proposal in respect of eleven subprojects relating to 37 schools, under the main project - GED005-00 'Upgrading one school from each constituency as Centre of Excellence' approved vide Government Order read 1% above, to be implemented by the Kerala Infrastructure & Technology for Education (KITE) with a total cost of Rs. 184.26 crore, as detailed in the Annexure, subject to ratification by the KIIF Board and with the following stipulations.

- A Tri-partite agreement, along with appended schedules, shall be entered after according of Technical Sanction by a competent Authority.
- ii. Block wise split-up of estimates are to be produced while according technical sanction and to be updated in the Master Programme to be submitted.
- iii. Cost estimate has been recasted by discarding non-applicable items included in the work like consultancy fees, contingency charges etc.
- iv. The detailed estimate submitted shall be reviewed by the TS authority considering the relevance of Cost Index and adherence of latest PRICE schedule. It is also suggested that the applicability and correctness of items detailed in the Estimates is fixed as the responsibility of the TS authority.
- v. The cost provisions for work alone shall be utilized for execution of work. The savings or anticipated savings from LA, QC, demolition etc. if any, shall not be re appropriated for meeting expenditure of work proper.

Government, through the Budget Speech 2017-18, had announced 'Betterment of Infrastructural Facilities in 229 Schools',(217+10+2) to be taken up as a project funded by KIIFB, subsequently designating Kerala Infrastructure and Technology for Education (KITE) as the Special Purpose Vehicle for executing the project.

Accordingly, Detailed Project Reports were submitted for following 4 schools, clustered into One sub-project named 'Augmentation of Infrastructure facilities in Malappuram District Cluster-4 Phase III' under the main project GED 008-00: Betterment of Infrastructural Facilities in 229 Schools based on Administrative Sanction issued vide Government Orders read 1st 2nd and 3rd above

The Detailed Project Reports were evaluated for adherence to KIIF stipulations, as per GO(Ms) No.315/16/Fin dated 08.08.2016 and GO(Ms) 69/2018/Fin dated 24.02.2018, and were found satisfactory and compliant.

The 7th Executive Committee that met on the 25th of April 2018, after considering the proposal and the appraisal reports, has approved the projects and sanction is accorded for funding the subproject "GED 008-61", to be implemented by the Kerala Infrastructure & Technology for Education (SPV) with a total cost of Rs. 11.99 Crore against the total original proposed of Rs. 14.71 Crore, with the following stipulation.

- 1. A Tri-partite agreement shall be entered and Technical Sanction by a competent Authority shall be mandatorily issued before signing schedule/s of the Tri-partite agreement.
- The detailed estimate submitted shall be reviewed by the TS authority considering the applicability and correctness of items specified in Detailed Appraisal Report, the relevance of Cost Index and adherence of latest PRICE schedule. (GST shall be applicable as per the prevailing norms and conditions)
- The cost provisions for work alone shall be utilized for execution of work. The savings or anticlpated savings from LA, QC, demolition etc. if any, shall not be re appropriated for meeting expenditure of work proper.
- 4. The SPV shall ensure that all obligations of the contractor during the defect liability period is performed without any additional cost.
- The investment criteria (CBR) meets the target standards but numerical values assigned to various benefit components are not supported with adequate primary or secondary data.
- The contract management plans are acceptable provided the documents and procedures are not in conflict with any of the rules and regulations with regard to public works execution prevailing in Govt of Kerala
- 7. A Detailed Appraisal Report of KIIFB on the project is appended for reference which shall be taken into consideration by the TS Committee while according Technical Sanction to the Project.
- 8. Wherever demolition is involved SPV should follow all procedures to be followed and see classes do not suffer on that account
- 9. The SPV shall ensure that the quantum of funds, exclusive of the KIIF contribution, required for financing the Project as a whole is available at its disposal, as and when the KIIF approved estimates are placed for the consideration of the Technical Committee. In case, such an option is not available, the SPV shall rework the estimates by pruning the Project requirement list to its most essential components and submit the same for approval of KIIFB before these are considered for TS.
