**COUNTER AFFIDAVIT FILED BY THE FIRST  
RESPONDENT IN THE ABOVE CASE**

I, M.T.Devasia, aged 55 years, S/o.Thomas Mathai,  
residing at Malappuram, do hereby solemnly affirm and state  
as follows:

1. I am the Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies  
(General), Malappuram and the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in the above  
Writ Petition. I am conversant with the facts of the case as  
disclosed from the relevant files. All the allegations and  
averments contained in the Writ Petition except those that are  
specifically admitted hereunder are denied.

2. The above Writ Petition is filed by the petitioner for  
a Writ of certiorari to quash Exhibit P5 and also praying for a  
declaration that the Co-operative Societies which are Banking  
Institutions for the purpose of Banking Regulations Act, 1949  
are outside the purview of Section 65 of the Co-operative  
Societies Act and therefore the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent is incompetent  
to issue Exhibit P5 and also other consequential reliefs.



3. It is submitted that the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner Nilambur Co-operative Urban Bank Ltd. No. F 1043 is a Primary Urban Co-operative Bank registered under the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act 1969. The working, constitution and functioning of the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner bank is regulated by the Provisions of the Banking Regulation Act as well as Kerala Co-operative Societies Act. The Reserve Bank of India had issued license to carry on banking business as per Section 56(o) of Banking Regulation Act, 1949 to the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner on 3<sup>rd</sup> December, 1986.

4. It is submitted that the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner is doing banking business within the purview of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949. Section 56 contained in Part V of the Banking Regulation Act extends the application of this Act to Co-operative Societies which are engaged in banking business. The 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner bank has to function in accordance with the directions as prescribed in the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 and the circular directions of the Registrar of Co-operative societies. It is submitted that the inspection mentioned under Section 66(1) of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act has not excluded any of the Urban Co-operative banks within its ambit. Section 35 of the Banking Regulation Act provides for inspection of the affairs of the banking institution by the RBI or officers appointed by the RBI for the purpose. By virtue of the Section 4A of Banking Regulation Act, if it is found necessary or expedient so to do, supply a copy of the report on any inspection or scrutiny to the State Co-operative Bank and the Registrar of Co-operative societies of the State. It does not mean that the legal steps initiated by the co-operative department under which the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner bank is registered had to escape from any action which found inevitable by this Respondent.

5. It is submitted that the report of irregularities were



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first brought to the notice of the Hon'ble Home Minister through a written complaint lodged by one of the members of 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner Bank on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2016. A true copy of the written complaint dated 22.02.2016 by one of the members of 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner Bank to the Home Minister is produced herewith and marked as Exhibit R1 (a). The said complaint was forwarded to the Registrar of Co-operative Societies for enquiry and consequently the same was forwarded to the respondent for enquiry. Follow up action was initiated by this Respondent by way of deputing Unit Inspector, Nilambur to conduct a preliminary enquiry and the report was submitted on 04.06.2016. A true copy of the preliminary enquiry report is produced herewith and marked as Exhibit R1(b).

6. It is submitted that on enquiry, it was revealed that the building construction was commenced before getting permission from this respondent and the costly Furniture, wooden doors and panes, window doors and panes etc. of demolished building were also replaced for disposal without the permission of Registrar as envisaged in the Rule 54(2) of Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969. As per Circular No. 55/2003 permission from the Registrar of Co-operative Societies is required before purchasing any vehicle by a co-operative society and as the rule is so an Innova Car was purchased for Rs:15,51,984/- without the prior permission of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies.


7. There were two posts of drivers as per the approved staff pattern but one additional driver was appointed without any approval from Registrar and another appointment was also done in the post of Business executive. The post of Business executive was not included anywhere in the Staff Pattern as detailed in Rule 135, Kerala Co-operative Societies Act.



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8. It is submitted that as per the guidelines issued through Circular No. 25/2007 dated 04.04.2007 by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, any irregularities pertaining to any of the co-operative societies in the state were reported through any of the medias including newspapers should be brought to the notice of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies as and when it appeared and conduct an inquiry in this regard by the Assistant Registrar or Joint Registrar concerned. It was an allegation raised by one of the members regarding irregularities in the construction of 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner bank's building and also on the unauthorized outward movement of the materials obtained on the demolition of the existing building. The action admissible in the Kerala Co operative Societies Act to enable an official to conduct an inspection was the only movement preferred by this Respondent at this juncture.


9. It is submitted that any co-operative society registered under the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act & Rules 1969 are under the control of Registrar of Co-operative Societies of the State of Kerala. This respondent holding certain delegated power under Section 3(2) of Kerala Co- operative Societies Act 1969 is responsible to respond on any complaint raised by any member of a society. To materialize this fact this respondent had issued inquiry under Section 65(1) (a) of Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969. It is true that the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner bank is a banking institution and it has to function as per Banking Regulation Act 1949. Even if it works so the rules and regulations which is applicable to a co operative institution as prevailed in the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act 1969 is not to be spared in any manner being a society registered under the said Act.



10. It is submitted that the Exhibit P5 order for an enquiry under Section 55 (1) (a) of Kerala Co-operative Societies Act 1969 covers various issues pertaining to certain irregularities on (a) construction of building (b) sale of material obtained on the demolition of existing building (c) Purchase of Innova Car and its usage and (d) appointment of driver and business executive. It was issued only after conducting a preliminary inspection through Assistant Registrar (General) Nilambur. Pursuant to the report of that Taluk Level Officer a reply was sought from the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner and when this Respondent went through the report, it was found that the compliance submitted was not satisfactory to avoid further action.

11. It was found in the preliminary inquiry that the construction of building was commenced before the formal clearance from the Department of Co-operation as contemplated in Rules 54 and 180 of Kerala Co-operative Societies Rule and also in various circulars issued by Registrar of co operative societies. Publication of advertisement for inviting Tender was made only in one news paper instead of two as prescribed by law and also by this Respondent in the preliminary sanction order which is marked as Exhibit P6. The expense incurred for the construction of the building was 6.20 crores. In the formal order of permission it was accorded sanction to utilize an amount to a tune of Rs.1.07 crores from the general fund and 5.43 crores from building fund of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner bank. No completion certificate from the authorized contractor was obtained and submitted even after two years of completion. The allotment of contract to one CI Construction, Ernakulam was made after an unhealthy negotiation in which an amount near to 75 lakh was reduced at first instance.


12. It is true that the windowpanes, Door frames etc of



the demolished building of the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner bank were made with Teak wood. As the teak wood furniture are costly in the open market, the 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner bank not considering its monetary value removed from the bank premises without even considering for any auction sale and also kept off the Rule 54(2) of Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules conditions.

13. It is submitted that as soon as a new Innova car was purchased, a new appointment was made to the post of driver without any permission from the Registrar of Co-operative Societies. When go through the log book of vehicles the purpose mentioned in the log book maintained for Innova car shows that the vehicle was used for unnecessary trips and no detailed reason for each trips were also not mentioned. Vehicle used by the Chairman without mentioning the purpose of travelling was 22,826 Km as per log book. Report of Assistant Registrar dated 04.06.2016 clearly mentioned these irregularities. Four Tyres of the vehicle were changed within a span of seven months, which shows the gravity of the damage caused to the Tyres. A true copy of the report of Assistant Registrar dated 04.06.2016 is produced herewith and marked as Exhibit R1 (c). The conditions prescribed for running a vehicle by a co-operative society is detailed in GO (MS) 113/2003/Fin dated 24.02.2003.

14. It is submitted that another provisional appointment was also made by the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner in the post of Business Executive as per the resolution dated 06.07.2015 without the prior approval of this Respondent. The staff pattern of the petitioner bank as approved by the Registrar had no such post in any of the categories. All these irregularities were pointed in Audit Report from the year 2014-2015 onwards. A true copy of the relevant pages of the Audit Report for the year 2014 -2015 is produced herewith and marked as Exhibit R1(d).





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It is further submitted that the petitioners have not raised any valid grounds in support of the prayers in the Writ petition, and therefore, it is humbly prayed that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to uphold the contentions of the respondent and dismiss the Writ petition with costs.

All the facts stated above are true to the best of my knowledge, belief and information.
