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Minutes of the meeting on Restructuring of Kerala Water Authority convened by the Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources on 14/5/2019 in his Chamber

List of participants is attached.

The meeting started at 11.30 a.m, with the Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources in the Chair and he welcomed the participants. The Managing Director, Kerala Water Authority informed that a meeting with the recognized trade unions was conducted on 4/5/2019. He also informed that suggestions on restructuring of Kerala Water Authority were also sought from the registered service organizations. Final proposal can be forwarded after examining the suggestions from the organizations. The Chief Engineer (PPD & WASCON) informed that the draft proposal is aimed at strengthening the existing revenue sections who are having more than 10000 water connections and the proposal was presented before the participants.

2. The Chief Engineer (WASCON) and Chief Engineer (HRD), Kerala Water Authority elaborated the proposals and the concept behind the restructuring so as to enable Kerala Water Authority, to improve the functions of Revenue Sections and to take up the operation of the schemes effectively.

3. The Secretary, Water Resources Department opined that the inputs of the previous report prepared by the IIM, Bengaluru and that of Sri. V.Ramachandran (Former Chief Secretary and Vice Chairman, State Planning Board) are to be taken into account. The present proposal should include improving NRW, Customer relations apart from reorganizing the staff.

After detailed discussion, the following decisions were taken:-

1. To revise the proposal for restructuring of Kerala Water Authority with definite set of goals and incorporating the recommendations of the report of IIM, Bangalore.
2. To refine the proposal to strengthen the existing Revenue sections by shifting existing posts and place in the Kerala Water Authority Board.
3. Proposals which need Government approval are to be forwarded to Government, with the approval of Board.
4. Urgent action is to be taken for posting Accounts Member. The possibility of relaxing qualification may be verified, if necessary.

5. It is proposed to fix a norm to reduce Non Revenue Water in future years. Priority shall be given to high NRW schemes initially.
6. To re-tender the proposal for engaging consultants for the preparation of DPR for the proposed Solar Project at Palakkad (Land available with Irrigation Department), after having the Detailed Project Report vetted by the Energy Management Centre officials.
7. To examine the possibility of providing house connections with the expense of Kerala Water Authority and recover the cost of connection from the consumer with the monthly water charges. Proposal for financing cost of connections either through bank/societies have to be prepared and a pilot project is to be implemented in any section office in Kerala.
8. To complete the Distribution network of the 128 schemes urgently in which other components are completed. Sunk cost has to be worked out and a separate proposals for sanctioning these schemes separately for rural/urban have to be prepared. Possibility of getting assistance from LSG institutions/MP/MLA Funds shall be explored. Priority shall be given to those schemes in which the Panchayats concerned have deposited the amount.
9. The list of Engineers and other staff with Masters Degree in Engineering/Business Administration/IT qualification, etc. is to be prepared for reference.
10. One scientist from EMC shall be included as a member of the Tender Committee of Kerala Water Authority for validating the tenders of electro mechanical works. Existing old pumpsets are to be replaced with energy efficient ones.
11. Suitable buildings and sites of Kerala Water Authority shall be located to install solar panels and the EMC, ANERT etc. shall be consulted for the implementation. EoI for consultant for solar panel implementation is to be finalized within a week and the same re-tendered immediately.
12. Proposals for replacing old pump sets with energy efficient pump sets in WTP schemes (209 Nos.) of Kerala Water Authority shall be taken up on a priority basis, based on need and after proper energy audit.
13. Proposals are to be taken up for remote reading of water connections who consume a large quantity of water (monthly consumption more than 50 KL)

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14. The possibility of installing flow meters to measure the flow in branch lines so as to minimize the losses shall be examined.
15. To take strict action against water theft as per the provisions in Water Supply Regulations.
16. Proposals shall be submitted to Government for disconnection of KSEB connection, in the case of the consumers of Kerala Water Authority who do not pay water charges even after the repeated notice (twice).

The meeting ended at 1.00 p.m.

ORDER

The Chief Engineer, Northern Region, Kozhikkode, had submitted a proposal during 2018, vide paper read 1 above for providing additional posts of Assistant Executive Engineer, Assistant Engineers and Technical support staff to the existing Project Division at Palakkad to carry out the ongoing and upcoming works. The matter was placed before the Authority for consideration. The Authority on 09-08-2018 discussed the agenda in detail and noted that there are about twenty two ongoing projects which are being implemented at an estimated cost of Rs.407.27 Crores under various schemes in Project Division, Palakkad. The Authority also noted the report that the present staff strength of project Division, Palakkad is not sufficient. Hence, the Authority

vide Resolution read as paper 2 above had resolved to approve the proposal for rearrangement of various existing post for the strengthening the Project Division Palakkad without any creation of posts and additional financial commitment. Accordingly, 13 posts were shifted to that Division vide proceedings read 3rd above. In the same resolution, it was noted that one more division at Palakkad may be required in future to carry out the incoming works and to place a status report on the work load of the Project Division and other related concerns.

Accordingly, the Chief Engineer, Northern Region, had submitted another proposal vide paper read 4 above explaining the need of a new Project Division in Palakkad district and details of work load under the areas of Palakkad and Shoranur. The Chief Engineer detailed the works under the area of jurisdiction of two O&M divisions of Palakkad district in various stages as follows.

Out of 28 ongoing projects, 19 are under Palakkad area and 9 projects are under Shoranur Area. It is reported that owing to the heavy workload and wide area of jurisdiction, the present Project Division may be bifurcated by forming one more Project Division under the circle. The area of jurisdiction of two project divisions is suggested as that of O&M Divisions i.e., Palakkad and Shoranur P.H.Division areas. With regard to the rearrangement of staff, the Chief Engineer (Northern Region) has reported that 14 posts from present project Division at Palakkad may be shifted to the newly proposed project division. Other posts including Executive Engineer, Divisional Accounts Officer and Junior Superintendent may be shifted from another Division where the projects are almost over.

Accordingly, the matter was placed before the Authority Board for a decision. The Authority Board has resolved vide paper read 5 above to form a new Project Division Office at Chittur in Palakkad district by rearranging the existing posts from Project Division, Piravom, Office of the CE (NR) and Project Division, Palakkad without creation of new posts. The Authority also resolved to maintain a new Project Sub Division at Piravom attached to the Project Division, Perumbavoor by abolishing the present Project Division at Piravom. The Board have entrusted the undersigned to take necessary action to execute the proposal. In the above circumstances sanction is hereby accorded to create a new Project Division office at Chittur under P.H. Circle, Palakkad. In order to provide the newly formed Division Office with sufficient number of staff/post, it is decided to make the following rearrangements without creation of new posts.

In the result, the existing Project Division at Piravom stands abolished. The present office at Piravom is re-designated as Project Sub Division, Piravom which is attached to the Project Division, Kattappana for administrative convenience as it is the Project Division in the same circle viz., Moovattupuzha, subject to ratification of the Authority. All files related to Division office shall be transferred to Project Division, Kattappana. The relieving of present incumbents in the shifted posts of Executive Engineer and Divisional Accounts Officer at Piravom shall be done only after completing such file transfer with proper documentation. All incumbents in the shifted posts are directed to hand over files to other staff working at present stations as per the instructions of the present controlling officers and they shall relieve the incumbents only after handing over the charge of concerned section to their counterparts.

The new Project Division, Chittur shall commence its function upon the joining of Sri.Biju.P.C., Executive Engineer before the Superintending Engineer, P.H.Circle.Palakkad in the capacity of Executive Engineer, Project Division, Chittur. The administrative control of new Project Division, Chittur will be vested with P.H.Circle, Palakkad. The area of jurisdiction of newly constituted Project Division at Chittur shall be co-terminus with the area of P.H.Division, Palakkad and the existing Project Division at Palakkad shall implement the projects coming

under the area of P.H.Division, Shornur. The Superintending Engineer, P.H.Circle, Palakkad is authorized to make further rearrangements required with regard to separation of Projects within Palakkad district for administrative convenience. The Superintending Engineer, P.H.Circle, Palakkad shall take necessary steps to provide necessary infrastructure for the functioning of this new Division at Chittur, Palakkad. The new Project Division office at Chittur and new Project Sub Division office at Piravom as per the above rearrangements shall take effect at the earliest.

ORDER

The Chief Engineer, Northern Region, Kozhikkode had submitted a proposal vide reference 1st above for providing additional posts of Assistant Executive Engineer, Assistant Engineers and Technical support staff to the existing project Division at Palakkad to carry out ongoing and upcoming works .The Palakkad Project Division is having ongoing works to the tune of Rs. 290.27 crores under AMRUT,NABARD,KIIFB, State Plan/NRDWP, etc which is now being managed by one Executive Engineer,3 Assistant Executive Engineers, 3 Assistant Engineers , 8 Draughtsman, 6 Overseers and other non technical staff. There is an estimated additional requirement of technical staff of one more Assistant Executive Engineer, 4 Assistant Engineers, and minimum 8 technical support staff for managing upcoming works to the tune of Rs. 378 crores under various heads of KIIFB.

Considering the quantum of ongoing works and upcoming works, this Division will have to be equipped with sufficient staff as requested by the Chief Engineer (NR), Kozhikkode. As instructed In the 404th meeting of the KWA Board a proposal of rearranging various existing posts for strengthening the Project Division, Palakkad to undertake new works was prepared after necessary consultation with the Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers and Executive Engineers concerned to arrive at a consensus in shifting of posts. The proposal for strengthening of Project Division Palakkad was placed before the Authority Board for a decision.

The Authority discussed the agenda in detail and noted that there are about twenty two ongoing projects which are being implemented at an estimated cost of Rs.407.27 Crores under various schemes. The Authority also noted the report that the present staff strength of Project Division, Palakkad is not sufficient. Hence, the Authority vide Resolution read 2nd above resolved to approve the proposal for rearrangement of various existing posts for strengthening the Project Division Palakkad without any creation of posts and additional financial commitment. In the above circumstances, the following shifting of posts are ordered.

ORDER

As per the letter cited 1st above the Chief Engineer, Northern Region has submitted the proposal for formation of new section office of Kerala Water Authority at Beypore under Rural Water Supply Sub Division, Malapparamba, Kozhikkode.

It is reported that Rural Water Supply Sub Division Malapparamba, Kozhikkode is one of the largest sub divisions under P.H.Division, Kozhikkode covering three Municipalities (Koduvally, Mukkam & Feroke), 27 Grama Panchayaths and part of Corporation of Kozhikkode including Blathur, Beypore, Nallalam and Cheruvannur areas. At present two section offices are functioning under this Sub Division, one at Koduvally and the other at Malapparamba. It is reported that the area of coverage is too vast to serve with only two section offices. The service to public cannot be delivered properly, especially at areas under Beypore constituency. A new section office at Cheruvannur can effectively cover areas like Beypore, Nallalam (presently under Kozhikkode Corporation), Kadalundy Panchayath, Feroke Municipality etc. The present section office at Malapparamba is quite far from these panchayaths. The Distribution network under JICA scheme is now operational in this area with around 6800 Nos of new water connections which have already been provided. There is a possibility of increasing the connections to a minimum of 15000 new water connections in this area if the responsibility is entrusted with a new section office at this locality. In addition to providing new connections, a new section office at Cheruvannur is essential for the proper maintenance of Water Supply Schemes in the area coming under Beypore LA Constituency.

The formation of a new section office is proposed with available staff under P.H.Circle, Kozhikkode. The Chief Engineer had submitted a proposal for redeploying Assistant Engineer and supporting staff from within the offices in

city without much displacement of staff. The office building is proposed to be constructed at Kerala Water Authority owned 50 cents of land at Chervuvaratt. At present this section office can be arranged to function temporarily at Kadalurdy Manam Kerala Water Authority pump house compound. Restructuring of Rural Water Supply Sub Division, Malapparamba is also proposed such that the newly formed section will continue under that sub division along with existing Kooduvally and Malapparamba sections. It is reported that implementation of this proposal will improve service delivery to the public.

Accordingly the matter was placed before the Authority Board for a decision. The Authority Board has resolved vide read 2nd above for the formation of new Section office of Kerala Water Authority named Rural Water Supply Section Beypore under Rural Water Supply Sub Division, Malapparamba under P.H. Division, Kozhikkode by deploying existing staff from various offices under P.H. Circle, Kozhikkode. The Board have entrusted the undersigned to take necessary action to execute the proposal for administrative convenience.

In the above circumstances, sanction is hereby accorded to create new Section Office at Beypore in the name of Rural Water Supply Section, Beypore under R.W.S. Sub Division, Malapparamba under P.H. Division, Kozhikkode by bifurcating existing Malapparamba Section. The Assistant Executive Engineer, Rural Water Supply Sub Division, Malapparamba shall administer the regular functions of the newly created Section office in addition to the existing Kooduvally and remaining portion of Malapparamba Sections. In order to provide the newly formed Section office with sufficient number of staff, post, it is decided to make the following re-arrangements without creation of new posts as detailed below:

O R D E R

The Deputy Chief Engineer, Planning Head Office had reported some practical difficulties in managing Deposit Works and State Plan works along with balance works under erstwhile JNNURM Project Circle which had been entrusted to that office upon the shifting of Deputy Chief Engineer's post from JNNURM Circle to Head Office. It is reported that Deputy Chief Engineer (Planning) is already entrusted with major project Planning, Planning and Monitoring of KIIFB and AMRUT projects costing about more than 5000 crores. Hence, supervising balance works under JNNURM projects scattered over two districts had become difficult in the absence of sufficient infrastructure and staff that is available with regular circles.

The proposal submitted by the Deputy Chief Engineer (Planning) for redeploying available staff to existing Project Divisions and Sewerage Division coming within the area of operation of JNNURM project works was examined in detail. Accordingly, a proposal for attaching JNNURM project implementation Units at Thiruvananthapuram and Kollam to Project Divisions of Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam and Sewerage Division Pattoor was formulated after necessary consultations with the officers concerned. The Sewerage Treatment Plant at Muttathara is to be retained under Sewerage Sub

Division, Kuriathy and the post of Assistant Executive Engineer presently at STP Muttathara is to be attached to Project Division, Thiruvananthapuram. Accordingly, the following are ordered.

1. The JNNURM PIU Kollam with one post of Assistant Executive Engineer (Sri.T.Thulaseedharan working), two posts of Assistant Engineers (Sri.Ajithkumar.J and Smt.Thara.G working) and the posts with incumbents of all supporting staff deployed at Kollam PIU are shifted and attached to Project Division, Kollam under the control of SE,PHC, Kollam. The balance works of JNNURM & ADB and AMRUT Sewerage works under the control of this PIU are attached to Project Division, Kollam. JNNURM Office Kollam will cease to exist and Service Books and all other allied matters of the shifted staff and files shall be handed over to Project Division, Kollam by Executive Engineer, JNNURM.
2. The JNNURM PIU Thiruvananthapuram, with one post of Assistant Executive Engineer attached to STP, Muttathara (Sri. Roy George working), two posts of Assistant Engineers (Sri.Anoop.M.R and Sri.Kiran.M working) and the posts with incumbents of all supporting staff deployed at this PIU are shifted and attached to Project Division, Thiruvananthapuram under the control of Superintending Engineer ,PH,Circle, Thiruvananthapuram. The Chief Engineer, Southern Region, Thiruvananthapuram is hereby entrusted to take necessary steps to redeploy supporting staff from JNNURM PIU, Thiruvananthapuram and the same shall be intimated to the undersigned forthwith. The works under State Plan and Deposit works other than balance works of JNNURM & ADB under the control of this PIU is attached to Project Division, Thiruvananthapuram. JNNURM Office Thiruvananthapuram will cease to exist and the Service Books and all other allied matters of the shifted staff and files shall be handed over to Project Division, Thiruvananthapuram by Executive Engineer, JNNURM.

3. One post of Assistant Engineer from STP, Muttathara (Sri. Joseph Arogyaraj working) and the posts of all supporting staff with incumbents are brought under the control of Assistant Executive Engineer, Sewerage Sub Division, Kuriathy under Sewerage Division, Pattoor which is in turn under the control of Superintending Engineer, PH Circle, Thiruvananthapuram. Executive Engineer, JNNURM PIU, Thiruvananthapuram shall hand over connected files and the Service Books and all other allied matters to the Assistant Executive Engineer, Sewerage Sub Division, Kuriathy.
4. The remaining staff under JNNURM PIU, Thiruvananthapuram namely two posts of Assistant Executive Engineers (Smt. Grace John and Sri. Vipin Chandran. P.R working), two posts of Assistant Engineers (Sri. Shiras. S.L. and Sri. Santhosh. S.T working) and all remaining staff under JNNURM, Thiruvananthapuram shall continue under the control of Executive Engineer (Smt. Sheeja Rani. C.R working) and shall be under the administrative control of Deputy Chief Engineer (Planning) to look after the completion of balance works of JNNURM & ADB. The establishment matters of the staff and finance and accounts matters shall be looked after by the Executive Engineer as such. Administration of establishment matters beyond the power of Executive Engineer shall be vested with Chief Engineer (Southern Region), Thiruvananthapuram. The Deputy Chief Engineer (Planning) while administering duties in the capacity of Project Coordinator, JNNURM PIU, Thiruvannathapuram shall report to the Chief Engineer (Southern Region) Thiruvananthapuram in connected matters.

The controlling officer concerned is hereby directed to relieve the incumbents noted as above forthwith. This order neither constitutes any new office nor creates new posts but is only intended for redeployment of staff for optimal utilization of human resources. The aforesaid rearrangements shall be given effect to immediately.



PROCEEDINGS OF THE MANAGING DIRECTOR.

Sub:- KWA – Estt – Formation of Project Sub Division Office at Kuttanad under Project Division, Kottayam and Re-deployment of posts - Orders issued.

ORDER

Sri.Thomas Chandy, Hon'ble MLA, Kuttanad while holding the Office of Hon'ble Minister of Transport has furnished a proposal for formation of new Project office of Kerala Water Authority at Kuttanad under Project Division, Kottayam which had been routed to Kerala Water Authority through the office of the Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources. Accordingly, a high level meeting was held on 16.09.2017 at Kerala Water Authority Head Office. Thus a detailed proposal was prepared and submitted to the Government for further direction in this regard. The Additional Chief Secretary, Water Resources Department had instructed to take necessary action to constitute a Project Sub Division at Kuttanad by placing the matter before the Kerala Water Authority Board.

At present in Kuttanad a 70 Crores Project under 13th Finance Commission is in progress. Under KIIFB another project worth Rs. 241 Crores is also on the anvil. The proposed project is a highly challenging one and will need a dedicated team for timely completion of the project. The current Project Division monitoring Kuttanad project is Project Division Kottayam. Owing to the topographical peculiarity of Kuttanad area effective execution from Kottayam cannot be ensured at present. Hence, there is a necessity of a new project office exclusively for Kuttanad to supervise ongoing works under the control of Project Division, Kottayam. In future the administrative control of newly formed Sub Division may be shifted to Alappuzha Project Division for monitoring the proposed works under KIIFB to the tune of Rs. 241 crores. Monitoring is a key requirement for the execution of this high value project at Kuttanad and hence formation of a new Project Sub Division has become inevitable.

The formation of a new Project Sub Division can be done by re-arranging the available staff under Project Division, Kottayam and Project Division, Alappuzha

without large-scale displacement of staff. The office space is proposed to be constructed at KWA premises under an existing O.H.Tank at Pallikkuttumma besides AC Road at Kuttanad utilizing ADS fund of MLA. Therefore, the implementation of this proposal will not create any additional financial commitment to KWA and will ensure effective and speedy execution of Water Supply Projects in Kuttanad area which carries high priority.

Accordingly the matter was placed before the Authority Board for a decision. The Authority Board had resolved vide reference 1 above to format a new Project Sub Division office at Kuttanad under Project Division, Kottayam by utilizing the services of existing staff from adjoining divisions with minimal displacement of staff. The Board have entrusted the undersigned to take necessary action to execute the proposal. In the above circumstances, sanction is hereby accorded to create a new Project Sub Division office at Kuttanad under Project Division, Kottayam. In order to provide the newly formed Sub Division office with sufficient number of staff/posts, it is decided to make the following rearrangements without creation of new posts.
