ORDER

Government vide G.O(Ms)No.203/08/Home dated, 01.12.2008 had accorded sanction for raising of one India Reserve Battalion based on the guidelines and terms and conditions stipulated by Government of India as per which

- a) The Battalion must be raised as per the standard pattern and on the prescribed scales for transport, wireless equipment, arms and ammunitions etc. as per the guidelines of Government of India.
- b) The Government of India would exercise the right of first call on the India Reserve Battalion and shall have a full authority to ask the state to make the Battalion available for deployment, anywhere in the country, as and when required. The State Government would be under obligation to comply with such requests wherever the Central Government feels the need for requisitioning the India Reserve Battalion.
- c) If the battalion is deployed to any state other than one that has raised it, on a request by the concerned State Government, pro-rata recurring expenses would be born in to by the borrowing State. Central Government shall bear the recurring expenditure when such deployment have been done to the exempt category States at the behest of Central Government i.e., without a request from the exempted category States. In all other situations the State Government concerned shall meet the expenditure on India Reserve Battalions.
- d) The State should also ensure that a sizeable segment (not less than 25% of the Battalion is trained as a Special Task Force. Commando Wing will be the Special Task Force component of the India Reserve Battalion as per letter No. 16011/8/2006-PF-IV(ix) dated 05.12.2008 of Ministry of Home Affairs with capabilities to work in the terrorists / militants infested areas.
- e) Recruitment of the personnel for India Reserve Battalions shall be made

by constitution of a Selection Board by the State, in which one of the members shall be an officer from the Central Police Forces, not below the rank of Commandant.

The recruitment Rules for the Police Constables of the India Reserve Battalion have been examined by Government in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission. The India Reserve Battalion will consist of two wings, viz. (i) Regular Wing and (ii) Commando Wing. The Government are pleased to issue the following orders prescribing qualification and method of appointment of the Police Constables in the above wings.

(i) Regular Wing (Men only)

Police Constables in the Regular wing of the India Reserve Battalion shall be recruited through the Kerala Public Service Commission. An officer not below the rank of a commandant of the CRPF/CPMFs shall be included as a member of the selection Board for Physical Efficiency Tests.

(a) Educational Qualifications - Pass in SSLC or its equivalent.

Note:- In the case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, candidates who have failed in the SSLC examination shall also be considered if sufficient number of qualified candidates are not available to fill up the quota of Police Constables reserved for the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes.

(b) Age - Must have completed 18 years and must be below 25 years of age as on the 1st day of January of the year in which the applications for appointment are invited.

Note:- The maximum age limit shall be relaxed upto 28 years for Other Backward Communities and 30 years for Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes and upto 40 years for Ex-Servicemen.

(c) Physical Qualifications

(a) (i) Height - 167 Cm.

(ii) Chest - 81 Cms. with a minimum expansion of 5 Cms.

Note :- Minimum height and chest measurement shall be 160 cms. and 75 cms. respectively for Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes candidates. The minimum chest expansion of 5 cms. shall, however be applicable for them also.

(b) Must be certified to possess the visual standards specified below without glasses.

Right Eye - Distant vision 6/6 Snellen, Near vision 0.5

Left Eye - 6/6 Snellen, Near vision 0.5

Note :-

(1) Each eye must have full field of vision.

(2) Colour Blindness, Squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or lids of either eyes shall be a disqualification.

(c) Must be free from apparent physical defects like knock knee, flat foot, varicose veins, bow legs, deformed limbs, irregular and protruding teeth, defective speech and hearing.

(d) Endurance Test (Qualifying)

All eligible candidates for appointment to the Regular Wing of the India Reserve Battalion have to undergo an endurance test which will be of qualifying nature, and shall consist of a Road Run of 3 Kms. to be completed in 13 minutes.

(e) Written test/OMR Test :

Those who qualify in the endurance test will have to undergo a written test/OMR Test conducted by Kerala Public Service Commission.

(f) Physical Efficiency Test:

PSC will prepare a list of candidates based on the Written Test/OMR Test consisting of Main list and Supplementary List and the number of candidates to be included in the list will be decided by the Commission. Those included in the list will be called for Physical Efficiency Test in terms listed below and must qualify in any 5 events out of 8 specified below of the National Physical Efficiency One Star Standard.

Note.(i). Those qualifying in the rank list will be subjected to suitable medical tests in such manner as may be decided by the Kerala Public Service Commission in which those found unsuitable shall be eliminated.

Note (ii). Candidates will be advised from the Ranked List by the PSC as per Rules for the number of vacancies reported to the Commission.

Note (iii). The Ranked list shall cease to be in force after one year from the date of finalisation of the Ranked List or after one month from the date of commencement of the Training course in respect of the last batch from the list within a period of one year from the date of finalisation of the Ranked List whichever is later.

(g) Training

Those selected for training as Trainee Police Constables of India Reserve Battalion shall undergo a pre-service training on a prescribed syllabus. The total duration of training of those recruited in India Reserve Battalion will be 18 months which will be divided into two phases of 9 months each. Phase I will be the basic

ing at any of the training institutions within the State or at any place outside the state and phase II will be the attachments to Army and other CPMFs. Phase I training will be again divided into Leg-one of six months duration and Leg-two of three months duration. After the completion of phase I of the training, an examination will be conducted for the recruits. Those failing will be liable to be discharged, if they do not clear the test despite two more opportunities given within one year. Those who complete the training successfully will be appointed as Police Constables in India Reserve Battalion. The period of training will not count for probation and increments in the time scale of pay.

(h) Bond

Those who get selected for appointment as trainee India Reserve Battalion Constable shall execute a bond to the effect that they will serve in the India Reserve Battalion for a period of 5 years after completion of training failing which they will have to remit an amount of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only).

(i) Stipend

Trainee Police Constables in India Reserve Battalion will be paid a monthly stipend equivalent to that of their basic pay during their period of training or as decided by the Government from time to time.

4. Probation.-

Every person appointed to Regular Wing of India Reserve Battalion, shall from the date on which he joins duty after successful completion of pre-service training be on probation for a total period of 2 years on duty with in a continuous period of 3 years.

5. Promotion

They will be eligible for promotion to the rank of Head Constable in India Reserve Battalion on completion of 3 years of service and passing the prescribed test.

6. Service Area

Those recruited will be liable to serve any where in India or under the Government of India or Government of other States, (as may be decided by the State Government).

7. Transfer to Armed Reserve

Constables in Regular Wing, India Reserve Battalion will be considered for appointment to the District Armed Reserve of their choice on transfer, after completing 10 years of actual service which will include all eligible leave except leave without Allowances. On such Armed Reserve transfer, they will be assigned seniority with effective from the date of effective advice of the Kerala Public Service Commission.

(ii) Commando Wing (Men only)

This wing will consist of directly recruited Police Constables which will be deemed to be a separate professional and specially trained special group within the India Reserve Battalion. The Commandos will be required to acquire certain attitudinal, physical and operational skills. They will be required to continuously undergo special training which will be quite specialised and highly demanding. They will be required to be subject to arduous and dangerous working conditions and will have to knowingly expose themselves to life threatening situations for saving others and for ensuring security. They will also be subject to special disciplinary requirements. Selection to this wing therefore has to be done by a special methodology. Those initially recruited will have to pass Special Commando Training Courses, only on the successful completion of which will they be given any Special Commando Allowance. They will be required to pass both the Police Recruit Training course and the Special Commando Training course satisfactorily within such time as the Director General of Police may specify. On failing either, they are liable to be discharged.

Recruitment of constables to the Commando wing, equivalent in rank and status to Armed Police Constables of the Battalions, will be done by a Special Board consisting of the following members :-

1. Chairman/ Member of the Kerala Public Service Commission (nominated by the Chairman)
2. Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department /Nominee.
3. A nominee of the Director General, National Security Guard (NSG).
4. Director General of Police, Kerala/ his nominee (Convenor)
5. A Social Scientist / Psychologist of the Department of Health Services/ Medical Education who is an expert in behavioural and attitudinal testing to be nominated by the Government of Kerala.
6. One Professor of Physical Education from the Collegiate Education Department/Universities in Kerala to be nominated by the Government of Kerala, wherever field test and physical test are necessary.

The Chairman/member of the Public Service Commission shall be the Chairman of the Board.

2. Appointment

(a) Educational Qualifications - Pass in SSLC or its equivalent.

(b) Age - Must have completed 18 years and must be below 22 years of age as on the 1st day of January of the year in which the applications for appointment are invited.

(c) **Physical Qualifications** - Physical Measurement and Qualification shall be the same as prescribed for the Police Constable in the Regular Wing of the India Reserve Battalion but with the condition that no relaxation in age, physical measurement and educational qualification shall be allowed for any special category.

(d) **Procedure for inviting applications** - The application will be invited by advertising in ten Malayalam News Papers and two National Dailies (English).

(e) **Endurance Test (Qualifying)**

All eligible candidates for appointment to the Commando Wing of the India Reserve Battalion has to undergo an endurance test which will be of qualifying nature, and shall consist of a road run of 5 Kms. to be completed in less than 25 minutes.

(f) **Written test/OMR Test :**

Those who qualify the endurance test has to undergo a written test/OMR Test conducted by the Special Selection Board. The written test/OMR Test will be conducted at pre-announced locations in such manner as the Board may decide and marks obtained in the test will be given a weightage of 50% in the ranking for the selection process, subject to such minimum qualifying marks as may be prescribed by the Board depending on overall performance.

(g) **Physical efficiency test:**

Those who qualify in the written examination as above will be called for Physical Efficiency Competitive Test in items listed below.

Those who achieve One Star performance will be awarded 3 marks, Two Star performance 5 marks and Three Star performance 6 marks. Achieving performance levels 10% better than Three Star standard in any item will be given a bonus of 1 mark subject to the limit that the maximum bonus mark will be limited to 2. A candidate shall get minimum of 20 marks for qualifying in the Physical Efficiency Competitive Test. Total of the points in the physical efficiency competitive test will be used for deciding the other 50% in the weightage. On the basis of the total marks of Written Test and Physical Efficiency Competitive Test the final rank list will be prepared, subject to minimum eligibility as decided by the Board.

Those qualifying in the rank list will be subjected to suitable medical, psychological, behavioural and attitudinal tests in such manner as may be decided by the Board in which those found unsuitable will be eliminated.

Wherever possible, video records will be made, throughout the process of selection. Such records and copies of any documentation of any kind will be preserved for a period of two years by an officer nominated by the Board with one copy given to the Chairman, Public Service Commission.

(h) **Reservation of appointment** - There shall be reservation as applicable to other public service, but without any relaxation in any criteria.

(i) Training

Those selected for pre-service training as Trainee Police constables of Commando Wing, India Reserve Battalion shall undergo training on a prescribed syllabus. The total duration of training of those recruited in India Reserve Battalion will be 18 months, which will be divided into two phases of 9 months each. Phase I will be the basic training at any of the training institutions within the State or at any place outside the State and Phase II will be the attachments to Army, NSG and other CPFs where Special training meant for commandos will be arranged for them. Phase I training will be again divided into leg-one of six months duration and Leg - two of three months duration. After the completion of Phase I of the training, an examination will be conducted for the recruits. Those failing will be liable to be discharged, if they do not clear the test despite two more opportunities given within one year. The Commandos will have to pass additional Special Training as may be prescribed. Those who complete the training successfully will be appointed as Police Constables (Commando) of India Reserve Battalion.

(j) Stipend

Trainee Police Constables in Commando wing, India Reserve Battalion will be paid a monthly stipend equivalent to that of their basic pay during their period of pre-service training or as decided by the Government from time to time.

(k) Probation

Every person appointed to Commando Wing of India Reserve Battalion, shall from the date on which he joins duty after successful completion of pre-service training be on probation for a total period of 2 years on duty with in a continuous period of 3 years.

(l) Bond

Those who get selected for appointment as trainee India Reserve Battalion Constable (Commando Wing), shall execute a bond to the effect that they will serve in the India Reserve Battalion for a period of 5 years after completion of training failing which they will have to remit an amount of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only).

(m) Special Allowances

The personnel in the Commando Wing will be eligible for such Special Allowances and Special Diet Allowances as may be decided by Government from time to time in addition to their normal pay and allowances.

(n) Service Area

Those recruited will be liable to serve any where in India or under the Government of India or Government of other States, if required.

(o) Transfer from Commando Wing to Regular Wing -

Personnel from Commando Wing are allowed to opt for Regular Wing / District Armed Reserve of their choice on completion of 10 years of satisfactory service in the Commando Wing counted from the date of joining for training but excluding period of leave without Allowance. They will also be eligible then, to be transferred to any Police Training Institution or to any Security related Special Unit without loss of rank, pay or seniority. Constables can continue in the Commando Wing till they attain 40 years of age after which they may be posted in other wings in the India Reserve Battalion.

(p) Transfer to Armed Reserve

Constables in Commando Wing, India Reserve Battalion will be considered for appointment to the District Armed Reserve of their choice on transfer, after completing 10 years of actual service which will include all eligible leave except leave without Allowances. On such Armed Reserve transfer, they will be assigned seniority with effect from the date of effective advice of the Special Selection Board.

(q) Promotion

They will be eligible for promotion to the rank of Head Constable in India Reserve Battalion on completion of 3 years of service and passing the prescribed test. The constables in the Commando wing will also be eligible for promotion as Head Constable in the Regular Wing in the India Reserve Battalion.

Special Rules for the above Wings will be issued separately.
