Sub:- The University Laws Amendment Ordinance, 2014- Faculty appointments -Filling up of backlog vacancies - Further clarification sought - reg.

Ref:- This office letter of even no. dated 28/03/2014.

In continuation to this office letter cited, the following further recommendations, with respect to filling up of the back log reservation vacancies, in faculty appointments in this University are put forth for approval -

Twenty nine existing back log reservation vacancies of Assistant Professors **(shown at Table-1)** coming under seven reservation communities, in sixteen subjects, in the University teaching departments are to be filled up urgently by notifying these vacancies.

In order to fill up the aforesaid 29 vacancies of Assistant Professors, spread over sixteen subjects / departments, the University will have to issue notification inviting applications from eligible candidates belonging to all the seven reservation communities specified above whose backlog remains to be filled. Inviting applications in such a manner, from all the seven reservation communities, irrespective of the reservation category allotted to each subject will ensure selection of the best candidates for each subject from each of the seven reservation communities concerned. It being necessary to clear the entire back log of 29 vacancies of Assistant Professors shown at Table -1 above and to fill up the vacancies ( as per Table 2) considering the subject based merit, till the backlog of all communities are over.

There however being the possibility of suitable candidates not being available under the allotted category for each subject the University may be permitted to initiate the following steps in this regard-

1. Invite applications from candidates belonging to the seven reservation communities in all the sixteen subjects,
2. Pool the subject wise rank list of all the seven communities and sixteen subjects.
3. Sort the pooled rank list based on community and prepare community wise rank lists (including candidates in different subjects)
4. By appointing the top rank holders of each community against the vacancies in different subjects, community back log can be filled up easily. This process shall be repeated in the case of all communities with backlog vacancies, in the order in which they are listed in the community rotation chart.

This is a one time process which will ensure merit and fair play and wipe out the entire community back log that remains to be filled in the case of Assistant Professor appointments.. Once the back log is done with, subsequent appointments can be done afresh, as per the Amendment Ordinance.

In view of the peculiar circumstance mentioned above, permission may be accorded to fill up the entire back log of reservation communities, as a onetime process .

Permission may also be accorded to clear this backlog through Special Recruitment Drive.

Sub:- Notification No.9833/ GA-II-C-SO/2013 dated 17/12/2013 -Frozen - Advice/ Clarification sought in making future appointments to faculty posts.

Ref:- The University Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2014 - Ordinance No.2 of 2014.

As per this University Notification No.9833/ GA-II-C-SO/2013 dated 17/12/2013, applications were invited to the following posts - **(a)** Assistant Professors in the various University Departments **(b)** Director, Academic Staff College, **(c)** Director, College Development Council and **(d)** Deputy Director, Physical Education. The said Notification had to be frozen as it failed, by inadvertence, in respecting the provisions in The University Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2014 - Ordinance No.2 of 2014, which came into force on 19/09/2013.

Communal reservation in appointments by direct recruitment came into force in the University in the year 1974 as per sub-section 2 of Section 6, Chapter II of Calicut University Act, 1975. Department wise / Category wise communal rotation has been followed in the University while making appointments to all faculty positions after the implementation of communal reservation in 1974 till date.

**(A) Post of Assistant Professor**

A total number of 241 appointments have been made to the post of Assistant Professors in the University, from the year 1974 till 2013, following communal reservation rules. **(TABLE -1 containing the detailed list appended)**

For the purpose of filling up the vacancies of Assistant Professors in accordance with the Amendment Ordinance, category wise appointments made in all departments have been taken into account and 29 backlog reservation vacancies have been identified. The backlog reservation vacancies to be filled are detailed below at **TABLE - 2**

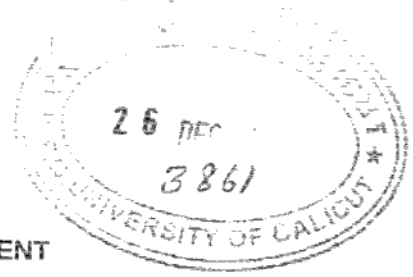

The Minimum Marks specified is that minimum without including any grace Marks.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET.
