ORDER

Revised guidelines for Certificate Attestation process of Norka-Roots was issued as per the G.O. read above. Subsequent to this, as per letters read as 2nd, 3rd and 4th papers above, Regional Certificate Authentication Officer, Norka-Roots, Ernakulam had requested to give more clarity to certain clauses in the guidelines.

(2)The Chief Executive Officer, Norka-Roots as per his letters read as 5th paper above submitted a proposal for modification in the guidelines to remove ambiguity in certain clauses to ensure hassle free attestation process.

(3)Government have examined the proposal in detail. Accordingly, in supersession of the existing guidelines for Certificate Attestation issued as per G.O. read above, Government are pleased to issue a revised guidelines for Certificate Attestation, appended to this order, in conformity with the guidelines issued by Ministry of Human Resource Development in this regard.

CERTIFICATE ATTESTATION

Attestation is the formal process of legalizing/validating a document by the designated authority from one country so that it could be valid in any other country.

Different attestation services:-

1.HRD attestation

Norka-Roots is the single authorised Government of India Agency in the State to undertake attestation of educational certificates, following Ministry of Human Resources Development [MHRD] guidelines.

2.Apostille Attestation

Apostille is a straight forward and effortless international document verification procedure. The word 'apostille' is derived from Italian language and the correct meaning is to authenticate or to certificate. With India's accession to the Hague Convention of 5th October 1961 abolishing the requirement of legalization of foreign public documents, Government of India, Ministry of External Affairs at CPV Division, Patiala House started issuing Apostilles w.e.f. August 29, 2007 through all regional passport offices in India. Apostille stickers, will be issued on the personal documents like birth, death, affidavits, power of attorneys, marriage etc. and educational documents like degree, diploma, matriculation and secondary level certificates. However, commercial documents are excluded from the purview of the Convention. Apostille attestation is now mandatory for 105 member countries of the Hague Convention.

3.MEA Attestation

This attestation is mandatory and done by Ministry of External Affairs for all the countries which are not a member of Hague Convention and where Apostille is not accepted. It is per-requisite for embassy attestation and obligatory after HRD attestation/Home authentication.

MEA attestation is applicable in:

- > Educational certificates
- > Non educational certificates
- > Commercial certificates

4.Embassy Attestation

Currently Norka Attestation Division provides following Embassy attestation services;

i.United Arab Emirates

ii.Bahrain

iii.Kuwait

iv.Qatar

v.Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

HRD attestation and MEA attestation are per-requisite for embassy attestation of educational certificates.

ATTESTATION GUIDELINES

- (1) Certificates issued by various Universities/Boards/Councils situated within the State of Kerala and Certificates issued by Central/State Government recognized private institutions for Government(Central/State) approved courses in Kerala.
- (2) Provisional certificates will be authenticated only within six months from the date of issue. (Provisional NTC certificates will be authenticated within two years from the date of issue).
- (3) Candidates having SSLC (prior to 2002) as their highest educational qualification should produce a certificate in prescribed format (Annexure-I) from the Head of the institution/School.
- (4) Certificates of deemed universities (constituted under the enactment of Parliament or State legislature)/Autonomous educational institutions including Government recognized Private institutions will be attested only after verification.
- (5) Candidates having Medical/ Nursing /Dental/Pharmacy qualifications should produce their Registration Certificate along with professional degree certificate.
- (6) In case of any minor spelling mistakes occurred in parent's name in 10th certificate/equivalent/passport or in any supporting documents would not invalidate the legitimacy of the educational certificates to be attested. In such

cases Authentication Officers can do attestations without any supporting affidavit.

- 6(a) Major changes in parents name (entire name change) in 10th standard certificate or its equivalent in contrary to their names in passport can be attested by accepting the one and the same certificate from the jurisdictional Village Officer. This is applicable for authenticating the SSLC alone.
- 6(b) In the case of attestation of certificates of higher qualification, SSLC is insisted only as a supporting document. In such cases changes in parent's name in the 10th Std certificate or its equivalent would not invalidate the authenticity of the certificate to be attested.
- (7) While mismatch or spelling mistakes in date birth or name of the applicant, the certificates will be accepted after making due corrections by Gazette notifications.

(8) Mark lists are attested in following cases;

 a) For those students who wish to join for higher studies in a Foreign University/Institution.

b) For Qatar Embassy attestation (Mark lists and Bonafide Certificates)

- c) As per the specific demand of the Foreign Employer especially to Kuwait and UAE based on submission of Specific request from the candidate.
- (9) Original certificates along with marks lists (Semester wise/Year wise) of all educational qualifications from Secondary School level onwards are mandatory for authenticating any certificate (Including all improvements and supplementary of all certificates).
 - 9(a) In absence of any of the above supporting certificates, the original certificate is authenticated after verification from the Universities concerned.
 - 9(b) Foreign nationals acquiring qualifications in India while applying for his /her certificate issued in India are exempted from producing the documents listed above. Certificates of Foreign nationals are authenticated after obtaining verification reports from University/ Board/Council etc.
- (10) The certificate holder should apply in the prescribed application form available in website of Norka-Roots [www.norkaroots.org].

(11) Attestation timing:

Timing for Authentication will be from 10.00 am to 04.00 pm (Monday to Friday only). District level attestation camps will be organised on Saturdays (Except 2nd Saturdays and Public holidays).

(12) Documents required for attestation:

(a) One recent passport size photograph of the certificate holder (one should be affixed on the application form).

(b) Copy of the passport specifically photo page, address page and page showing validity (original passport should be produced at the time of registration)

registration).

- (c) Original and copy of 10th Standard/SSLC certificate is necessary for authenticating any certificate. In the absence of SSLC book clause 9 (a) is applicable.
- (d) Original and copy of all certificates, which is to be authenticated.
- (13) In addition to certificate holders, the following persons are also authorized to submit application for authentication along with their Electoral Identity Card/Ration card.
 - a) Parents of the certificate holder.
 - b) Spouse of the certificate holder.
 - c) Siblings of the certificate holder.
 - d) in the absence of above (a, b or c), any third person can submit applications with a written authorization (in Annexure-2) of the certificate holder along with an id proof (copy).

NB:- Multiple authorizations will not be accepted from a third person at a time.

(14) Authentication Reports:

Applicants can check the authentication reports in the official website of Norka-Roots (www.norkaroots.org). Respective Certificate Attestation. Centers will update the daily status accordingly.

(15) Certificates authenticated without prior verification:

- ✓ All certificates issued by various Universities in Kerala (Annexure-3)
- Certificates issued by Secretary, Board of Public Examinations, Kerala, viz SSLC, Type Writing (Lower/Higher) Certificates, Short hand (Lower/Higher) Certificates, TTC Certificates and such other certificates.

- Certificates awarded by Chairman, Board of Examiners on behalf of Directorate of Medical Education (Ex. D.Pharm, D.M.L.T, D.MRT etc...)
- ✓ DNB Certificates issued by National Board of Examiners, will be authenticated provided, the applicant should have completed the course from any of the Medical Colleges in Kerala and it should be added as an additional qualification in their TC Medical Council Registration Certificate.
- Certificates issued by NIOS will be authenticated provided the applicant should register in any of the regional centers of NIOS in Kerala and should appear for the examination in any of the centers inside the State of Kerala. Candidate should produce a certificate in this regard from the authorities concerned.
- Certificates issued by KNC viz GNM, ANM Certificates.
- NCVT/SCVT Certificates including National Apprenticeship Certificate, issued by NCVT
- Equivalency Certificate for Standard 10 issued by Kerala State Literacy Mission.
- ✔ HDC/JDC Certificates
- ✓ HSE/VHSE Certificates
- CBSE/ICSE Certificates. (The respective schools should be within the jurisdiction of the State of Kerala)

(16) Certificates authenticated with prior verification:

- MS, MD, M.ch, DM and various medical diploma Certificates (DGO, DLO, DA etc.) possessed by a candidate will be sent for verification if such Qualification are not added in their TC Medical Council Registration Certificate as additional qualification.
 - M.PhiL, PhD Certificates.
 - Certificates awarded by following institutions;
 - 1. NIT Calicut.
 - Sree Chithira Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences & Technology, Thiruvananthapuram.

- 6. Indian Institute of Management, Kozhikode.
- National University of Advanced Legal Studies (NUALS).

- ✓ All Certificates issued by Central/State Government recognized deemed/autonomous/private institutions for Government (Central/State) approved courses in Kerala.

(17) Certificates which are not authenticated:

- Certificates issued by unrecognized (State/Central Governments/Agencies) Private Agency's various registration certificates.
- Mark Lists except for those students who wish to join for higher studies in a foreign University/institution and also for Qatar Embassy attestation.
- Rank Certificates.
- SET NET Certificates,
- Internship Certificates
- Equivalency Migration Certificates.
- Apprentice certificates except National Apprenticeship Certificates issued by NCVT.
- Training certificates.
- Bonafied Certificates except for Qatar Embassy attestation.
- (18) Regarding the operational aspects of the attestation Chief Executive Officer, Norka-Roots is authorized to take appropriate decision as and when required on public interest.
