Dear Sh. Chandyji

As you are aware, the Central Sector Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) has the objective of correcting the imbalances in availability of affordable/ reliable tertiary level healthcare and to augment facilities for quality medical education in different States. The intention of the Central Government has been to develop the AIIMS as a model medical teaching and medical research Centre. I am glad to inform you that two batches of MBBS students and the first batch of BSc Nursing students are receiving education at each of the six new AIIMS set up in the States of Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Bihar, Chhattisgarh and Uttarakhand. Indoor patient facilities in the hospitals of these AIIMS are also functional in a limited way.

To cope with the increasing number of critical care cases due to which patients from the region have to travel long distances for treatment and considering the requirement of pursuit of high standards of medical education and of delivery of quality healthcare in the light of disease burden, it is strongly felt that the PMSSY should cover a larger region necessitating its further expansion.

In his address to the joint session of the Parliament after the constitution of the 16<sup>th</sup> Lok Sabha, Hon'ble President has announced that for addressing the shortfall of health care professionals, health education and training will be transformed. AIIMS like institutes will be established in every State in a phased manner.

Accordingly, I would request that your Government may kindly identify three or four suitable alternate locations for setting up of a new AIIMS. Approximately two hundred acres of land at a location are required for establishment of one AIIMS-type Super-Specialty Hospital-cum-Teaching Institution. The location should have road connectivity, availability of water and electricity. The State Government has to undertake to provide, free of cost, land and other required infrastructure such as suitable road connection, sufficient water supply, electricity connection of required load and regulatory/statutory clearances. Cost of construction and running of the new AIIMS would be met by the Central Government under PMSSY.

Upon receipt of the details about the alternate locations, a Central Team will be sent to the State for inspection of the alternate sites (locations) before finalization of the site. Since our plan now is to take up a few AIIMS on a priority basis, I request you to kindly send your response on land locations and other infrastructure within a month. I look forward to your response within a month, so as to proceed in an expeditious manner.

As required in your letter, Government of Kerala have identified Four suitable alternate locations having the essential requirements of land, road connectivity, availability of water, electricity etc. The alternate locations identified by the State Government are the following:

1. Land at Kinaloor in Kozhikode District under the possession of Kerala Small Industries Development Corporation
2. Land adjacent to open Jail at Nettukaltheri, Thevankode, Kattakada Taluk in Thiruvananthapuram District
3. Land at Kottayam under the possession of Government Medical College, Kottayam
4. Land under the possession of HMT at Ernakulam District.

I would like to request you to expedite action to send the Central Team for inspection to finalise the most suitable location and to take necessary steps for establishing the institution in the State of Kerala.

I would be grateful if permission is granted for establishing the institution in the State in the next phase itself.

*Dear Sir,*

I would like to bring to your kind attention to the long pending request of the State Government for the sanction of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in Kerala. As you aware , the State Government has been requesting the Union Government for the setting up of AIIMS in Kerala for decades.

The Hon'ble Union Minister, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India had informed about the Central Sector Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) has the objective of correcting the imbalances in availability of affordable/reliable tertiary level healthcare and to augment facilities for quality medical education in different States. The Hon'ble President of India, in his address after the constitution of the 16th Lok Sabha has announced that for addressing the shortfall of health care professionals, health education and training will be transformed and for the same, All India Institute of Medical Sciences(AIIMS) like institutes will be established in every State in a phased manner. Accordingly, the State Government was requested to identify 3 or 4 suitable alternate locations having approximately 200 Acres of land at a location for the establishment of one AIIMS-type Super Speciality Hospital cum Teaching Institution. It was also specified that the State Government has to undertake to provide free of cost land and other required infrastructure such as road connection, sufficient water supply and electricity connection of required load and regulatory/statutory clearances. It was further reported that the cost of construction and running of the new AIIMS proposed to establish in the all States would be met by the Central Government under PMSSY and upon receipt of the details about the said alternate locations.

Accordingly the State Government identified the land at Kinaloor in Kozhikode District for establishing AIIMS in Kerala. The matter was communicated to GOI vide letter No.S3/393/2016-Health dated 09/01/2017 (copy attached). Thereafter the State Government has been requesting the



Government of India for sanctioning AIIMS in the State (communications placed below). The State Government has identified the land at Kinaloor in Kozhikkode district and the details of sketch and land details are attached below. The DME has conducted site inspection and identified 155 acres suitable land for establishing AIIMS (copy of report). The land at present is with Government owned Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation (KSIDC). As per the Government decision dated 20/09/2021, the said land is earmarked for AIIMS and to be transferred to DME. The formalities of getting land in the name of Director of Medical Education is in the final stage. Date: 18<sup>th</sup> May 2022


In order to save time, I request a team may be deputed for feasibility study and we shall ensure all the statutory formalities shall be complied with.
