## **Financial Business**

### *(1) Budget for 2015-2016*

During the Fourteenth Session 13 days were allotted for the discussion on Demands for Grants in the Budget for the Financial Year 2015-2016.

Out of 41 cut motions received, none of them was moved. There were 182 occasions for speech including reply by the Ministers in connection with the discussion and voting on Demands for Grants.

The Assembly devoted 43 hours and 57 minutes for transacting financial business relating to the Budget for 2015-2016. The details are given in Appendix IX and X.

The Appropriation (No. 2) Bill, 2015, in respect of the Budget for the year 2015-2016 was introduced by the Minister for Finance, Law and Housing on 23-7-2015. The Bills were taken up for consideration and passed on the same day. The House devoted 23 minutes for the business.

### *(2) Supplementary Demands for Grants*

On 24th July 2015, the Minister for Finance, Law and Housing laid before the House the first batch of Supplementary Demands for Grants for the year 2015-2016.

The Discussion and voting on the first batch of Supplementary Demands for Grants took place on 29th July, 2015 and the House devoted 3 hours and 36 minutes for the transaction of the business.

The Kerala Appropriation (No. 3) Bill, 2015, in respect of the first batch of Supplementary Demands for Grants for the year 2015-2016 was introduced in the Assembly on 30th July, 2015. The Bill was taken into consideration and passed on the same day. The House devoted 28 minutes for the business.

## **Private Members' Business**

According to the calendar of sittings of the Fourteenth Session of the Thirteenth Kerala Legislative Assembly, two days were allotted for transacting Private Members' Business viz. 10th and 24th of July, 2015. Though two days were set apart for transacting Private Members' Business, the House transacted Private Members' Business only for 1 day i.e. on 24th July, 2015. During the Session, the House devoted 35 minutes in toto for Private Members' Business.

### ***Private Members' Bills***

During the Session, the Business relating to Private Members' Bills, scheduled for 10th July was not transacted since there was no sitting of the Assembly on that day.

### ***Private Members' Resolutions***

During the Session, one day, i.e., the 24th July, 2015 was allotted for transacting Private Members' Resolutions. Three Resolutions and the continuation of the discussion on one resolution were scheduled to come up before the House. At first, the House considered the pending discussion on the Resolution which had already been given notice and moved by Smt. E. S. Bijimol, M.L.A. on 20-6-2014. The Minister for Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Printing and Stationery replied to the points raised in the discussion. After the reply, the Resolution, moved by Smt. E. S. Bijimol, M.L.A. was put to vote and declared lost. Then the First Resolution, Scheduled for 24-7-2015 given notice of by Shri V. P. Sajeendran, M.L.A. was moved in the House. Since the discussion remained inconclusive, it was left for continuing the discussion for the next allotted day.

The details regarding the name of Members' who moved the Resolutions, the text of the Resolution and the results thereof are given in Appendix XI.
