Hindi may become must till Class X in CBSE schools

Students of schools affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) may have to compulsorily study Hindi till Class X with recommendations of a parliamentary panel in this regard getting the President's nod. The Ministry of Human Resource Development has also been instructed to form a policy in consultation with the State governments to make the language compulsory.

Centre promises election reforms

The Union government told the Supreme Court that it had constituted a task force to frame a road map for implementation of the Law Commission's recommendations on decriminalisation of politics. A Bench of Justices Ranjan Gogoi and Navin Sinha asked the Centre to file an affidavit during the day on a PIL petition seeking debarment of convicts for life from contesting polls and stopping them from entering the judiciary and the executive. The Bench listed it for final hearing on July 10.
