### GUJARAT

#### **Boat ambulance service for fishermen in Gujarat**

With a view to strengthening health security network in the state with the help of updated communication technologies, Chief Minister Vijay Rupani launched '108' boat ambulance service. He also launched a mobile application to streamline the operations of the '108' ambulance service in the state, run by GVK Emergency Management and Research Institute (EMRI), a non-profit organisation. The app was launched by Rupani and deputy CM Nitin Patel at the GVK EMRI Centre at Naroda. Introducing the app, Rupani exhorted people to download the app to secure maximum use of well-integrated communication technology modules in saving human lives in accidental cases.

### KARNATAKA
