ORDER

Hon'ble Speaker in consultation with Hon'ble Chief Minister is pleased to appoint Justice Rajendra Babu, Retired Judge, High Court of Kerala (Former Secretary, Kerala Legislative Assembly) to study and make recommendations to revise the Salaries and allowances to Ministers, Speaker, Deputy Speaker, the Leader of Opposition, Government Chief Whip and Members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly.

I. The terms of references of the study shall be as follows :

(1) to consider and suggest modification or enhancement, if found necessary for :

- (i) the Salaries and Allowances to Ministers, Speaker, Deputy Speaker Leader of Opposition and Government Chief Whip.
- (ii) the various Allowances to the Members of Legislative Assembly including T. A.
- (iii) the Medical Facilities and Accident Insurance to Ministers, Speaker, Deputy Speaker, Leader of Opposition, Government Chief Whip, and Members of Legislative Assembly.
- (iv) the Pension, Allowances, Medical facilities and free-transit facility to the Ex-members of Kerala Legislative Assembly with special emphasis on The Medical Attendance to Ex-members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly Rules, 1988.

(2) to examine and suggest necessary amendments to The Payment of Salaries and Allowances Act, 1951, The payment of Pension to Members of Kerala Legislature Act, 1976 and the Rules already made thereto in lieu of the enhancements suggested.

(3) to examine and suggest any allied matters in connection with the above subjects.

II. While making recommendations, the Salaries, Allowances and other benefits available to the Members of Parliament and Members of other State Legislatures and Pensionary benefits extended to them and the financial position of the State shall be taken into account.

III. The Report shall be submitted on or before 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2011.
