**RESUME OF BUSINESS TRANSACTED DURING THE FIRST
SESSION OF THE ELEVENTH KERALA LEGISLATIVE
ASSEMBLY**

The Eleventh Kerala Legislative Assembly was constituted on May 16, 2001 after the General Election held on May 10, 2001 (General Election to the Assembly was conducted using electronic voting machine in 140 Constituencies for the first time). An Eight Member Ministry headed by Shri A. K. Antony assumed office in the forenoon of 17th May, 2001 and the Ministry was expanded with the induction of 12 more Ministers on 26th May, 2001.

The Summons dated May 30, 2001 for the First Session of the Eleventh Kerala Legislative Assembly was issued to members on May 30, 2001.

The Session commenced at 9.00 a.m. on Tuesday June 5, 2001 and adjourned sine-die at 2.00 p.m. on Monday, July 23, 2001. The Session which was scheduled to meet till July 26, 2001 was cut short to July 23. During the Session Assembly met on the following dates viz. June 5, 6, 29, July 2, 4, 5, 13, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 23, 2001 (12 days of Sittings). The House transacted Business for 51 hrs. and 26 minutes.

Oath of Office:

The Members assembled for swearing at 9.00 a.m. on Tuesday June 5, 2001 in the Assembly Chamber, Legislature Complex, Thiruvananthapuram. Shri K. Narayanakurup who was appointed by the Governor to perform the duties of the Speaker under Article 180 (1) of the Constitution was in the Chair (Shri K. Narayanakurup took oath before the Governor on May 30, 2001). The Secretary informed the House that under Article 180(1) of the Constitution. The Governor has appointed Shri K. Narayanakurup to perform the duties of the Speaker and that under Article 188 of the Constitution the Governor has appointed Shri K. Narayanakurup as the person before whom Members of the newly elected Legislative Assembly shall make and subscribe oath or affirmation according to the form set out for the purpose in the third Schedule to the Constitution. One hundred and Thirty seven members took oath or affirmation and signed the Roll of Members. (Shri P. Sanjayan and Shri A. C. Shanmugha Das took oath/affirmation on 11-6-2001 before the Speaker at his Chamber).

Election of Speaker:

Two members viz. Shri T. K. Balan and Shri Vakkom Purushothaman had been duly nominated as candidates for election as Speaker. The election was conducted at 9.00 a.m. on June 6, 2001 with Shri K. Narayanakurup,

Protem Speaker in the Chair, Shri Vakkom Purushothaman secured 95 votes and Shri T. K. Balan secured 39 votes. One vote was invalid. Shri Vakkom Purushothaman therefore declared elected as Speaker.

Announcement regarding recognition as the Leader of Opposition:

On June 6, 2001 the Speaker announced that Shri V. S. Achuthanandan, Leader of Communist Party of India (Marxist) has been recognised as the Leader of Opposition since his party is the largest one in the Opposition.

Governor's Address:

The Governor Shri Sukhdev Singh Kang addressed the members of the Legislative Assembly at 9.00 a.m. on June 29, 2001. The discussion on the Motion of Thanks to the Governor's Address commenced on July 2, 2001 with Shri Aryadan Mohamed moving the following motion,

“2001 ജൂൺ 29-ാം തീയതി ഗവർണ്ണർ മേൽ നിയമസഭാംഗങ്ങളുടെ ചേർന്ന “സന്ദേശത്തിന്” നിയമസഭാംഗങ്ങൾ ഗവർണ്ണർക്ക് നന്ദി രേഖപ്പെടുത്തുന്നു.”

The discussion on the Motion of Thanks lasted for 3 days viz. July 2, 4, and 5, 2001. The Motion was adopted on July 5, 2001. The House devoted 9 hrs. and 47 minutes for the discussion on the Motion of Thanks and 53 Members including Ministers participated in the discussion.

The Governor's reply to the Motion of Thanks was reported to the House on July 16, 2001.

Motion for suspension of Rule:

On July 18, 2001 Shri M.M. Hassan, Minister for Information and Parliamentary Affairs, moved and the House adopted the following Motion:

Motion Under Rule 130:

On July 23, 2001 Shri E.M. Augusthy moved the following Motion Under Rule 130.

After discussion and reply by Shri K.M. Mani, Minister for Revenue and Law Shri E. M. Augusthy moved the following substantive motion Under Rule 275.

കേരളത്തിൽ ഈ വർഷം നേരിട്ട കാലവർഷപ്പെയ്തുകൂട്ടുടെ ഭീകരതയും കായികവ്യായാമവും അതിവിപുലമായ മുതിരനിവാരണ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളും പുനരധിവാസ നടപടികളും ആവശ്യമായിത്തീർന്നിരിക്കുന്നു. ഇതിലേക്ക് വേണ്ടിവരുന്ന ഭീകരമായ ചെലവ് സംസ്ഥാനത്തിന്റെ സാമ്പത്തിക കഴിവുകൾക്ക് ഉപരിയാണ്. അതിനാൽ ഗതകാര്യ കമ്മീഷൻ വെള്ളപ്പൊക്കം ഭൂമിത നിവാരണത്തിനായി സംസ്ഥാനത്തിന് നിശ്ചയിച്ചിട്ടുള്ള വിവിത ത്തിനുപരി സംസ്ഥാനത്തിന് ആവശ്യമായ സാമ്പത്തിക സഹായം കേന്ദ്ര ഗവൺമെന്റ് നൽകണമെന്ന് ഈ സഭ ആവശ്യപ്പെടുന്നു."

The amendment moved by Shri P.C. George to the substantive motion was put to vote and declared lost. Then the motion was adopted by the House unanimously.

2. On July 23, 2001 as authorised by Shri V.S. Achuthanandan, Leader of Opposition, Shri T.K. Balan moved the following Motion under Rule 130.

കാർഷിക വിളകൾക്കും, വ്യവസായിക ഉല്പന്നങ്ങൾക്കും അനുബന്ധമായ മാക്സിമം സബ്സിഡി അനുവദിക്കണമെന്നും തേങ്ങയൂക്കം തെങ്ങിലെ ഉയർത്തുകയും അതേവഴിയിൽ കോപ്രാ സംരക്ഷണ പുനരനുഭവിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യണമെന്നും സബ്സിഡി കയറ്റും കാർഷിക വിളകളായി പരിഗണിച്ച് അതിന്റെ ഇറക്കുമതി ചുരുക്കിച്ച് ബാങ്ക് റേറ്റ് നിശ്ചയിക്കണമെന്നും സബ്സിഡി വില്പനക്ക് സബ്സിഡി സംഭരിക്കണമെന്നും കേന്ദ്രഗവൺമെന്റിനോട് അഭ്യർത്ഥിക്കുന്നു. കാർഷിക-വ്യവസായിക പുനരധിഷ്ഠിപ്പിക്കൽ ആവശ്യമായ റൂറൽ റൂറീകരിച്ചും ഇന്ത്യയ്ക്കുവേണ്ടിയുള്ള സഹായങ്ങൾ നൽകിയും നയങ്ങൾ ആവിഷ്കരിച്ചും കേരളത്തെ സമ്പന്നമാക്കി തകർച്ചയിൽ നിന്ന് രക്ഷിക്കാനുള്ള നടപടികൾ കേന്ദ്രഗവൺമെന്റ് സ്വീകരിക്കണമെന്നും ഈ സഭ കേന്ദ്രഗവൺമെന്റിനോട് അഭ്യർത്ഥിക്കുന്നു."

Question of Breach of Privilege:

On July 23, 2001 The Speaker informed the House that consent had been withheld to the notices given by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan and Shri K.P. Rajendran against Shri A.K. Antony, Chief Minister, alleging that the latter has committed breach of privilege of the House by publishing the white paper before presenting it in the Assembly or distributing it among the members.

The Speaker also informed that the notice given by Smt. Mercy Ravi against 'Desabhimani' Daily alleging that the report published in it on July 19, 2001 under the heading "സംവരണങ്ങൾ വിലക്ക" കൂട്ടിച്ചിട്ടി" was intended to defame the Speaker is under the consideration of the Chair.

Legislative Business:

1. *Bill Passed*

The Kerala Appropriation (Vote on Account No. 2) Bill, 2001 introduced on 23rd July, 2001 was taken into consideration and passed on the same day. The House devoted 1 hour and 5 minutes for discussion on the Bill and 7 Members including Minister for Finance and Excise participated in the discussion.

2. *Bill Introduced*

The Kerala Finance Bill, 2001 was introduced in the Assembly on 23rd July, 2001.

Laying of Bills assented:

The following Bills as assented to by the Governor were laid on the Table of the House by the Secretary on July 2, 2001.

*Financial Business:*1. *Revised Budget for 2001-2002*

Revised Budget for 2001-2002 together with the Alteration Memorandum was presented by the Hon'ble Finance and Excise Minister on 13th July, 2001. The general discussion commenced on 16th July, 2001. Three days were allotted for the general discussion on the Budget. The House devoted 9 hours and 30 minutes for this business. 53 Members (including Minister for Finance and Excise and Minister for Revenue and Law) participated in this discussion.

2. *Vote on Account*

The vote on Account for four months (August to November) for the year 2001-2002 was presented on 13-7-2001. The Minister for Finance and Excise moved the motion regarding Demands for Grants on Account towards defraying charges towards the months of August to November 2001-2002 on 19th July, 2001 and the discussion on the Vote on Account was held on the same day. The House devoted 3 hours and 29 minutes for this business. 25 Members (including Minister for Finance and Excise and Minister for Revenue and Law) participated in this discussion.

The Kerala Appropriation (Vote on Account No. 2) Bill, 2001 in respect of Demands for Grants on account was passed on 23rd July, 2001.
