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## RESUME OF BUSINESS TRANSACTED DURING THE FIFTH SESSION OF THE ELEVENTH KERALA LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

The summons dated December 18, 2002 for the Fifth Session of Eleventh Kerala Legislative Assembly were issued to the Members on December 31, 2002. The session commenced at 9.00 a.m. on Friday, January 24, 2003 and adjourned sine die at 8.44 a.m. on Tuesday, March 18, 2003. Even though 36 days of sittings were scheduled as per the Calendar, 16 days of sittings were cancelled. The House met on the following days viz. January 24, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, February 13, 14, 18, 19, 20, 21, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, March 14, 17 and 18, 2003 (20 days of sitting). The House transacted business for 65 Hours and 26 minutes.

### **Governor's Address**

The Governor Shri Sikander Bakht addressed the Members of the Legislative Assembly at 9.00 a.m. on January 24, 2003.

National Anthem was sung before and after the Address of the Governor to the House for the first time.

The discussion on the Motion of Thanks to the Governor's Address commenced on January 28, 2003 with Shri K. Narayanakurup moving the following motion.

Amidst the discussion at 11 a.m. on January 30, 2003, the house stood in silence for two minutes in memory of the martyrs of freedom movement.

''മറ്റു പ്രതിപക്ഷാഗ്രഹം സഭാ കവാടത്തിൽ അനിശ്ചിതകാല നിരപ്പാക്കം ആരംഭിച്ചതിനെ തുടർന്ന് മൂപ്പത്തിയാറ് ദിവസം സമ്മേളിക്കാൻ തീരുമാനിച്ചു ചേർന്ന നടപ്പുസമ്മേളനത്തിലെ എട്ട് വിലപ്പെട്ട ദിനങ്ങൾ ഇതിനകം തന്നെ നഷ്ടപ്പെട്ടിരിക്കുകയാണ്. ജനാധിപത്യ പ്രക്രിയയിലെ ഏറ്റവും പ്രധാനപ്പെട്ട ബഡ്ജറ്റ് അവതരണം വോട്ടും സങ്കുചിത രാഷ്ട്രീയ പ്രകൃഷ്ടങ്ങൾക്കു വേണ്ടി അലങ്കോലപ്പെടുത്താൻ ശ്രമമുണ്ടായി. സഭയിൽ അഴിഞ്ഞാട്ടം നടത്തിയ ചില പ്രതിപക്ഷാഗ്രഹങ്ങൾ ധനകാര്യമന്ത്രിയെ കടന്നുകൂട്ടിക്കൊണ്ട് ശ്രമിക്കുകയും വോട്ട് ആൻഡ് വാർഡ് ജീവനക്കാരിൽ അഞ്ചുപേരെ ആക്രമിച്ചു പരിക്കേറ്റിപ്പിക്കുകയും ചെയ്തു. മാർച്ച് പതിനാലിന് സഭയിൽ അറുങ്ങനിയ സംഭവങ്ങൾ ജനാധിപത്യ വിശ്വാസികളുടെ ഹൃദയത്തിൽ ഏൽപ്പിച്ച മുറിവ് ഉണങ്ങാൻ കാലമേറെയെടുക്കും. തുടർന്നും ഈ പ്രവണത ആവർത്തിക്കാനിടയുണ്ടെന്ന് ഇന്നത്തെ സംഭവങ്ങൾ സൂചന നൽകുന്നു.

ഈ സാഹചര്യത്തിൽ ഭരണഘടനാപരമായി പൂർണ്ണമായും സാമ്പത്തിക നടപടിക്രമങ്ങൾ സമയബന്ധിതമായി തീർക്കേണ്ടതിനാൽ, 2003-2004 സാമ്പത്തിക വർഷത്തെ ബഡ്ജറ്റ് ചർച്ച കൂടാതെ സബ്ജക്ട് കമ്മിറ്റികളുടെ പരിഗണനയ്ക്ക് അയയ്ക്കണമെന്നും വോട്ട് ഓൺ അക്കൗണ്ട് ചർച്ച കൂടാതെ ഇന്നുതന്നെ പാസാക്കണമെന്നും 2003-ലെ കേരള ധനവിനിയോഗ (ക്രനാം നമ്പർ) ബില്ലും 2003-ലെ കേരള ധനവിനിയോഗ (വോട്ട് ഓൺ അക്കൗണ്ട്) ബില്ലും ഇന്നുതന്നെ പരിഗണനയ്ക്ക് ഏകീകരിക്കണമെന്നും ഈ സഭ

### Motion for suspension of Rule

On March 18, 2003, the House adopted the following motion moved by Shri M. M. Hassan, Minister for Information and Parliamentary Affairs:

### Question of Breach of Privilege

On March 18, 2003, the Speaker informed the House that consent has been withheld to the following notices of Breach of Privileges:

1. Notice given by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan against the Minister for Finance and Excise alleging that the reply given to a submission raised by the Leader of Opposition on 15-3-2002 regarding the discussion with ADB was meant for deliberately misleading the House.
2. Notice given by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan against the Minister for Agriculture and Coir alleging that correction had been made in the Kerala Agricultural University (Amendment) Bill, 2001 which was passed by the House during the second session and forwarded to the Governor for his consent.
3. Notice given by Shri K. P. Rajendran against Shri K. M. Mani, Minister for Revenue and Law alleging that the announcement made by the latter during the Demand discussion relating to Revenue Department in the Fourth Session to the effect that the eviction of occupants, in Mathikettan was stopped by the previous Government was unfounded.
4. Notice given by Shri B. Vijayakumar, against the Leader of Opposition alleging that the reference made by the latter at

a press conference on 19-10-2001 regarding the suspension of three opposition members and the issuance of passes to the press photographers were aimed at defaming the Speaker.

5. Notice given by Shri A. K. Balan against Shri M. V. Raghavan, Minister for Co-operation alleging that the latter had misled the House without disclosing the truth regarding the land owned by Pariyaram Medical College.
6. Notice given by Shri B. Vijayakumar against Shri Sebastian Paul alleging that the reference made by the latter in the articles published in Kerala Kaumudi Daily on 28-5-2002 and 23-6-2002 relating to the instructions on the telecast of Assembly Proceedings were aimed at defaming the Speaker and the Members of the House.
7. Notice given by Shri V. K. Chandran against the Minister for the Welfare of Backward and Scheduled Communities alleging that the answer to Unstarred Question No. 1073 dated 25-6-2002 relating to spending of Adivasi Fund was aimed at misleading the House.
8. Notice given by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan against the Minister for Electricity alleging that the answer to Starred Question No. 189 dated 25-6-2002 relating to the consultants of ADB loan and aid scheme was false.
9. Notice given by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan against the Minister for the Welfare of Backward and Scheduled Communities alleging that the latter had misled the House by not disclosing the truth regarding the deposit of Adivasi Welfare Fund in the joint account of Adivasis and the Tribal Officers.
10. Notice given by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan against the Minister for Finance and Excise and the concerned officers and notice given by Shri K. P. Rajendran against the Minister for Finance and Excise alleging that the reply given by the Minister in the Assembly to a submission raised by the Leader of Opposition on 7-12-2001 regarding the crisis faced by the Poultry Farmers was false.

The Speaker also informed that the following notices of breach of privilege are under the consideration of the Chair:

1. Notice given by Shri G. Prathapavarma Thampan and Shri B. Vijayakumar alleging that the Leader of Opposition had made defamatory references about the Speaker at a Press Conference.
2. Notice given by Shri Kodyeri Balakrishnan against the Chief Minister alleging that the statement made by the latter in the House, that not even a single piece of land was given to the landless Adivasis during the L.D.F. rule, was false.

3. Notice given by Shri K. P. Rajendran against the Minister for Fisheries and Tourism alleging that the statement made by the latter in the House, that it was in continuation of the Cabinet decision during the tenure of the previous L.D.F. Government to handover Pathiramanal to Oberoi groups, was false.

The Budget for 2003-04 was presented by the Minister for Finance and Excise on 14th March, 2003. General Discussion on the Budget was not held in the Assembly. The Budget Estimates were referred to the Subject Committee for scrutiny without discussion.

##### 2. *Final Supplementary Demands for Grants for the year 2002-2003:*

The Minister for Finance and Excise laid on the Table the final Supplementary Financial Statement for the year 2002-2003 on March 14, 2003. Discussion on the final Supplementary Demands for Grants for the financial year 2002-2003 took place on 17th March, 2003. Two members participated in the discussion and the Assembly devoted 35 minutes for the discussion and the same was passed without voting.

The Kerala Appropriation (No. 1) Bill, 2003, in respect of the Final Supplementary Demands for Grants for the financial year 2002-03 was introduced, considered and passed on 18-3-2003 without discussion.

##### 3. *Vote on Account:*

Vote on Account for the first four months (April-July, 2003) of the Financial year 2003-04 was presented on 14th March, 2003 and it was not discussed in the House.

The Kerala Appropriation (Vote on Account) Bill, 2003 in respect of the Demands for Grants for the First four months (April-July, 2003) was introduced, considered and passed on 18th March 2003 without discussion.

#### **Private Members' Business**

According to the Calendar of Sittings of the Fifth Session of the Eleventh Kerala Legislative Assembly, 6 days were set apart for Private Members' Business i.e. on January 31, February 14, 21, 28 and March 7 & 21, 2003. Out of these only 3 days were utilised for the transaction of Private Members' Business. 31st January and 21st February, 2003 were utilised for transacting Private Members' Bills and 14th February, 2003 for Private Members' Resolutions.



*Private Members' Bills:*

During the Session, notice for 12 motions for leave to introduce Bills came up before the House. All the motions for leave to introduce the Bills were opposed by the Minister for Information and Parliamentary Affairs. The motion for leave to introduce 2 bills were withdrawn by leave of the House. Discussion on 10 Bills were inconclusive.

Details regarding the name of members who moved the motion for leave to introduce the Bills and the results thereof are given in Appendix IX A and B.

*Private Members' Resolutions:*

During the Session notice for resolutions were given by Shri P. K. K. Bava (moved by Shri K. Kutty Ahammed Kutty), Shri C. P. Mohammed and Smt. Girija Surendran. Discussion on the Resolution given notice by Shri T. U. Radhakrishnan which was partially discussed in the House on 12-7-2002 was continued and was withdrawn by leave of the House. Discussion on the Resolution given notice by Shri P. K. K. Bava and moved by Shri K. Kutty Ahammed Kutty was inconclusive. Resolutions of Shri C. P. Mohammed and Smt. Girija Surendran were not moved for want of time.

## APPENDIX VI

**Salient Features of the Bills passed***The Kerala Court Fees and Suits Valuation Amendment Bill, 2002*

A comprehensive amendment to the Kerala Court Fee and Suits Valuation Act, 1959 was made by the Kerala Court Fee and Suits Valuation (Amendment) Act, 1991 (6 of 1991). The Government have now felt that the Act need be amended again so as to effect timely changes in the Court fee collected under the Act.

2. The requirement of payment of fees for Income Tax Appeals and Wealth Tax Appeals to the High Court was done away with the Finance Act, 1999 and it is provided that with effect from 1-6-1999, the fee for filing an Income Tax or Wealth Tax Appeal to the High Court shall be such fee as may be specified in the relevant law relating to court fees for filing appeals to the High Court. Hence Government have decided to introduce court fees for the appeals filed in the High Court against the orders of Income Tax Tribunals and Wealth Tax Tribunals by incorporating a new section, viz section 52A and by amending Article 3 of Schedule II of the Act.

3. Petition to the High Court under Article 226 of the Constitution for a writ other than the writ of Habeas Corpus or a petition under Article 227 of the Constitution have been exempted from payment of court fees so far. The Government have now decided that court fee shall be introduced to such petitions also. Hence it is proposed to delete item (xxxi) of section 72 of the Act.

4. In accordance with Schedules I & II of the Kerala Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1959, Government have to pay proper court fee for filing plaint, Memorandum of Appeal, petitions, other pleadings and all other documents before courts. Government have noticed that much difficulties are being experienced by the office of the Advocate General and Offices of Government Pleaders in meeting the expenditure towards the court fees on plaints, petitions etc. presented on behalf of the State before courts. Government have examined the matter in detail and decided to exempt the State from payment of court fees under this Act by inserting a new section, namely, section 73 A.

5. As per section 81 of the Kerala Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, where the Court Fee already paid is directed to be refunded to any person by an order of the Court, the Collector may, on application of the person concerned, may pay to him the amount of fee. As per this provision, to refund the fees, further order of the Collector is mandatory. The amendment proposed to section 81 is to dispense with the above requirement.

6. As per Article 10 (g) of Schedule 11, the fee for attestation of private document intended to use outside India is Rupee one. By G.O. (Ms.) No.46/85/Home, dated 25-2-1985, the fee of attestation of these document was enhanced to Rs. 5. It is decided to enhance the rate to Rs. 10. Consequent on the enhancement of the pecuniary jurisdiction of the Munsiff's Courts by the Kerala Civil Courts (Amendment) Act, 1986 (33 of 1986) and the Kerala Civil Courts (Amendment) Act, 1996 (Act 6 of 1996) amendments to Article 11 (ka), 11(n) and 17 of Schedule II of the Act are considered necessary to suitably revise the rate of court fee.

7. It is decided to enhance the court fees in the case of original petition and Writ Appeals from Rs. 20 and Rs.10 to Rs. 100 per petitioner and Rs. 200 per appellant respectively. It is also proposed to empower the High Court to impose process fee for serving and executing processes issued by the High Court as per section 83(1) (a) in its original jurisdiction also.

8. The rate of court fee for other items under Schedule I and Schedule II are also proposed to be revised.

9. The Bill is intended to achieve the above objects.

#### *The Abkari (Amendment) Bill, 2003*

Speedy disposal of seized liquor, intoxicating drugs or articles has been a problem for the enforcing officers under the provisions of the Abkari Act, 1 of 1977, in the absence of a provision similar to that in section 52A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Central Act 61 of 1985). The Honourable High Court had also in its order dated 22nd December, 2000, in O.P. No. 27767/2000, given directions to bring in necessary provisions of law for the purpose of speedy disposal of the spirit taken into custody by the police and excise authorities in connection with the investigation of various offences under the Abkari Act. Taking into consideration all the above aspects, the Government have decided to amend the Abkari Act, 1 of 1977, for the purpose of speedy disposal by the Government of any liquor or intoxicating drugs or articles as soon as they are seized, after following the procedure specified therein by inserting a new section 53A in the Act.

As the Legislative Assembly was not in session and the proposal had to be implemented urgently, the Abkari (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002 (7 of 2002) was promulgated by the Governor on the 31st August, 2002 and was published as Ordinance No. 7 of 2002 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1298 dated the 3rd September, 2002.

This Bill seeks to replace Ordinance No. 7 of 2002 by an Act of the State Legislature.

*The Kerala General Sales Tax (Amendment) Bill, 2002*

As per sub-section (4) of section 17 of the Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963 there is provision for mandatory acceptance of returns filed by dealers whose turnover is Rs. 15 lakhs or below, those dealing in exempted goods, those dealing in goods at non-taxable points and whose tax liability does not exceed Rs. 5,000. The number of dealers under sub-section (4) of section 17, have been increasing and as of now 70% of the registered dealers come under this category. These dealers have the advantage that they need file returns only once in a quarter, whereas others have to file monthly returns. There is chance for tax evasion in the category and many tax evasion cases detected recently are of dealers coming under this category. In order to check tax evasion and to widen the tax base, Government have decided that the facility under sub-section (4) of section 17 in respect of exempted goods need be made available to the dealers having dealings in exempted goods coming under the Third Schedule irrespective of any limit in turnover and in respect of goods sold at non-taxable points, only if their annual turnover is Rs. 40 lakhs or below. It is also decided that a dealer who has been found to suppress turnover or evade tax will not be entitled to continue in this category, irrespective of the quantum of turnover and that all dealers with turnover exceeding Rs. 40 lakhs, who claim the benefit of sub-section (4) of section 17 will be required to file monthly returns. For the above purpose, Government have decided to amend the Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963 suitably.

As the Legislative Assembly was not in session and the proposal had to be implemented urgently, the Kerala General Sales Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002 (9 of 2002) was promulgated by the Governor on the 25th October, 2002 and was published as Ordinance No. 9 of 2002 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1533 dated the 26th October, 2002.

This Bill seeks to replace Ordinance No. 9 of 2002 by an Act of the State Legislature.

*The Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit (Amendment) Bill, 2003*

The Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit has made a proposal to the Government to amend the provisions of the Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit Act, 1994, so as to enable the University to accord recognition to educational institutions like the Kerala Kalamandalam, which conduct courses of study in Fine Arts such as Music, Drama and Painting according to the Indian traditions and provide facilities for study and research in the cultural diversity, ancient art and literature of Kerala. Accordingly, Government have examined the matter in detail and decided to amend the Act to specify the Kerala Kalamandalam as the recognised institution under the University. It was also decided to authorise the University to confer degrees on those who have undergone the courses of study in the Kerala Kalamandalam and passed the examinations conducted by the University.

As the Legislative Assembly was not in session and the proposal had to be given effect to immediately, the Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002 was promulgated by the Governor on the 26th day of November, 2002 and the same was published as Ordinance No. 10 of 2002 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1761 dated the 28th November 2002.

This Bill seeks to replace the said Ordinance by an Act of the State Legislature.

#### *The Kerala Value Added Sales Tax Bill, 2002*

In the conference of State Chief Ministers and Finance Ministers held in New Delhi on 16th November, 1999, it was agreed upon by all States that Value Added Tax which is accepted all over the world as a transparent system of taxation, be introduced by all States with effect from the 1st April, 2001. The date was subsequently postponed to 1st April, 2003. The Government have accordingly decided to enact a new legislation for the purpose, repealing the Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963.

The Bill seeks to achieve the above object.

#### *The Kerala Appropriation (No. 1) Bill, 2003*

The Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 204 (1) of the Constitution of India, read with Article 205 thereof, to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala required to meet the supplementary expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala and the grants made by the Legislative Assembly for the expenditure of the Government of Kerala for the financial year 2002-2003.

#### *The Kerala Appropriation (Vote on Account) Bill, 2003*

The Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 204 (1) of the Constitution of India, read with Article 206 thereof, to provide for the appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Kerala of the moneys required to meet the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State and the grants made in advance by the Legislative Assembly in respect of the estimated expenditure of the Government of Kerala for a part of the financial year 2003-2004.
